

BBQ Fundraising with Delta Co-op

First – Apply to host a fundraising BBQ at one of our grocery locations. Once your application has been approved, our location manager will contact you to confirm the booking. Bookings are made on a first come, first served basis.

Second - The location of choice for your BBQ will contact you to follow up with more information. Your local location manager will be able to walk you through the process once you book a BBQ. We take BBQ bookings starting on Monday, January 19, 2026. After April 3, 2026, bookings open again to any previously booked groups to schedule a second fundraising date for the season. Our BBQ season is from May until September.

We have everything you need to run a successful and smooth BBQ! What do you need to bring on the day of your BBQ? Just a minimum of 4 volunteers that will work the BBQ and aid with the cleanup after the BBQ is completed.

BBQ Guidelines

1. Customers are to fill out all necessary forms at time of booking.
2. Set up is at 10:00am and close/clean up shortly after 1:00pm.
3. All products provided by the Co-op.
4. Minimum of 4 volunteers needed to help BBQ and serve food/beverages.
5. Cash float for event provided by Delta Co-op.
3. Fundraisers will assist with wiping down the BBQ, utensils, and tables.
4. Delta Co-op will provide the following:
 - Access to our membership and customers
 - Two tables
 - Professional BBQ
 - Propane
 - Ice
 - BBQ utensils [we do not have table utensils for the BBQs]
 - Retail space and support of our customer service team
 - One Co-op team member to assist with BBQ item(s) replenishment.

NOTE: We transfer products at cost and then all profits go to the fundraising group.

We ask that each non-profit only book 2 fundraisers per season to allow other groups to have access to BBQ dates.

Health and Safety Practices for BBQs

Our team leader will go over Health and Safety practices the morning of the BBQ with your fundraising team.

Sharing your fundraising with our followers:

The Delta Co-operative Association Limited may allow groups within the Delta Co-op trading area access to our retail locations to fundraise for their organization. Normally supported groups are: Not-For-Profit Organizations; Sporting Organizations; Elementary and High Schools; and Cultural Organizations.
